Professional Ballet School will once again offer a fun and diverse summer program for ages 4 and up.

Summer is the time when students can immerse themselves in dance and make the most progress. We strongly recommend that dancers attend as many classes as possible. There is a 2 week break after the June performances followed by 6 weeks of summer session, then a whole month off. Missing a total of 12 weeks sorely negates hard earned technical achievements and progression to the next level.

Class level requirements remain the same, with the exception of workshops. Students may choose to attend 4,5 or 6 weeks (need not to be consecutive). Also, students unable to attend 4 or 6 weeks may do drop-ins at \$15.00 each class, but classes without enough pre-registered students will be dropped from the schedule.

Ballet curriculum will include Pre – Ballet 1,2&3, Levels 1-3, & 4/5/6. In addition the Summer Intensive Workshop for level 4-6 will include Pointe, Repertoire, Pilates, Jazz, Contemporary, Hip-Hop, Ballet Appreciation, and new Pas de Deux and Character classes with several guest instructors.

Jazz curriculum includes Jazz 1, Jazz 2&3, Jazz 4, Jazz 5 and Ballet for levels 4 and 5. All Jazz dancers are also encouraged to take Ballet, Pilates and Hip-Hop.

Due to Tanya Bello's professional engagements, she is unable to confirm her availability every Tuesday. She will alternate with a guest instructor teaching Contemporary 2&3. Due to small class size Contemporary 1 classes will not be scheduled. They may be offered as occasional drop-in classes as summer progresses.

Please note that classes with an* by them are open to all students.
